- Applicant must have an over all 2.5 Grade Point Average
- Applicant must be enrolled in a Trade School, College or University by Fall of 2021
- Applicant must be a full-time student.

- To pursue a career in their field of endeavor.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS WILL BE EVALUATED ON THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA. ALL DECISIONS BY THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL.

- Participation in conservation activities-----0 to 50%
- School, community, church, and other organizational activities-----0 to 10%
- Jobs held while attending high school
(Average monthly hours worked) ----- 0 to 10%
- Essay-----0 to 30%
